Adult Day Services at The Baptist Home

Day Services at The Baptist Home can offer relief to both caregivers and the recipients of that care.



The elderly frequently need care and family members often serve as the primary caregivers. Over time,

the caregivers own health and well-being can suffer as they sacrifice on behalf of their loved ones. They often find it difficult to run errands, maintain a career or simply find time to be alone. Day Services at The Baptist Home can provide much needed relief to the caregiver.

It may not be as obvious that those receiving that care can benefit from the same relief. They may feel restless from being stuck at home with fewer opportunities to visit with friends or meet new people. Day Services at The Baptist Home can help meet many of spiritual, emotional, physical, social and security needs.

These issues are normal and should be addressed rather than suppressed.

Through the Riggs-Scott Care Center, The Baptist Home seeks to extend its ministry and services to those who need care but are not yet ready for long-term care in a facility setting.

Philosophy of Care

The Baptist Home believes that love should be the focal point for developing a philosophy of care. As part of this commitment to provide loving care The Baptist Home practices a unique form of emotional care-giving called Validation Therapy. This method requires special education for the staff and is more difficult and time consuming than many alternative therapies. The Baptist Home pioneered Validation, working directly with its founder, Naomi Feil, in the 1980s and becoming an international center for the study of this kind of therapy in a long-term care setting.



Validation therapy seeks to understand a person's frustration or confusion rather than simply force them back into the caregiver's reality and convenience.

What To Expect

The Riggs-Scott Care Center provides planned social and recreational activities, including nutritious meals and snacks, from 6 am to 6 pm, Monday through Friday. The care plan, diet, and administration of medications and other treatments are under the supervision of The Baptist Home's qualified and registered staff.

Day Services at The Baptist Home provide primary caregivers of elderly family members a safe place to bring their loved ones. Those who participate in the program will be enriched through activities designed to promote mental, physical and spiritual wellness.

Included Amenities

Quiet room with Recliner and Television is available.
Balanced meals and snacks each day.

Regular activities may include:

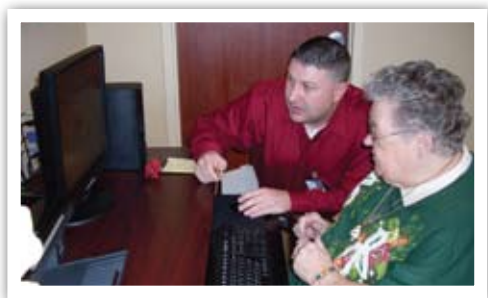
- Crafts

Pricing & Specifics

Day Services Rates:

Half Day - \$40 (4 1/2 hours, w/one meal)

Full Day - \$60 (9 hours, w/one meal)

Additional Hours - \$5.00 per hour (beyond a 9 hour stay, not to exceed 12 hrs.)

Additional meals - \$3 per meal

- Payment by cash, check or credit card (Mastercard or Visa).
- Personal Care Services available upon request.
- Planned social and recreational activities.
- Licensed nursing staff on duty.

Application Process

To apply for entry into the program you will need to complete and submit the following:

- Riggs-Scott Day Services Application
- Medication Summary
- Review and sign the Admission Policy

Once received, your application will be reviewed and you will be invited to visit and discuss your needs with Administrator Sherri Snider.

Licensing

The Riggs-Scott Care Center is currently a non-licensed Adult Day Care program. However, The Baptist Home is a state licensed long-term care facility and the nursing staff are experienced, licensed caregivers.

Requirements

All participants must be able to assist with their own feeding, transferring and toileting. The use of a walker or cane is permitted.
